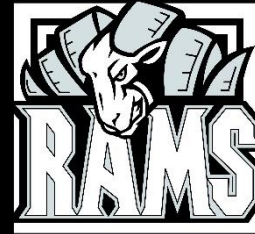

Coaches Comments: The Whites took the long drive out Narre Warren East to play South Belgrave in a city vs country clash. With the sounds of Puffing Billy in the distance and the surrounds of a magnificent country ground, Brett Kelly and Scott Smith took control of the coaching duties for the day.

From the first bounce our on ball crew attacked fantastically, which resulted in a scrambled goal for Tom Lane from the goal square and minutes later Dylan Hanrahan snapped a goal on the run. With so much of the play in our forward half, our defence saw little of the ball.

The second quarter started the same as the first but our inaccuracy around goals as well as South Belgrave having so many players around the ball stopped any real ball movement. This type of play by the opposition continued into the third and fourth quarter, which clearly was frustrating many of our players. 
