In the second quarter our defence keep rebounding really well off the half back line with Paddy, Will R, Brayden and Dan Rossi for the first 5 minutes but in the midfield we kept getting second to the footy with the opposition getting all the clearances. Kilsyth managed to use the wind effectively by using the guts and put on 4 unanswered goals.

The 3rd quarter was hoping to be the premiership quarter kicking with the wind again, however our team was not being effective with the ball and not kicking to the hotspot. we started to get some momentum with great shepherds and bumps by Will A, Goldie and Luke Garlick giving Jonty and Will R space to move the ball forward. However again we only managed 1 Goal 2 Behinds.

The coaches asked the boys to lay it on the line and show everyone what they are capable of, with their backs against the wall kicking against a 3 goal breeze, they were first to the footy, hitting targets and being effective with the ball in hand. Some great transitions of play with Searlie, Devan, Angus and Cameron stepping up and pushing the ball forward. A great captains goal in the dying minutes gave us a 10 point advantage, enough to seal the game and show everyone what teamwork can do.


